



Our Criteria for Selecting Culturally Responsive, Student-Centered Texts

Are diverse characters accurately illustrated?

Texts that teach about Black/African American contributions to the United States beyond the Civil Rights Movement

Main characters who are BIPOC (black, indigenous, or people of color)

Main characters who represent non-traditional gender roles

Characters who represent and affirm the LGBTQ+ community (gender identity and gender expression)

A range of family structures and family configurations

Characters with diverse abilities

Different socioeconomic backgrounds

Religious diversity

Human characters versus non-human, anthropomorphic main characters (e.g., talking animals, talking trucks, talking vegetables, imaginary creatures, etc.)

- Newly published authors and award-winning titles
- Titles with themes tied to common Pre-K curriculum, including Beginning of the Year, Insects, Signs, Tunnels, Recycling, Simple Machines)
- Titles that connect to ELA standards for Pre-K, and in the content areas of art, science, and math
- Collection includes nonfiction texts and wordless books
